

LETTER FROM THE FOUNDER AND CEO

Dear Friends,

As I take a moment to reflect on 2023, I am filled with a profound sense of gratitude for God's faithfulness. Ministry impact is at an all-time high!

This year, we celebrated the addition of a new floatplane in PNG, new staff families moving to Wewak, and the expansion of a new ministry area in the Gulf Province.

We had the most impactful ministry year to date. We flew 40% more life-saving flights than ever before, which means more people are hearing the life-saving message of Jesus.

2023 also marked a significant milestone as we began developing our newly purchased land in Wewak. This property will allow us to have eight staff houses, a training center, and our national headquarters for years to come!

Simultaneously, we are developing a second base in the Gulf Province, partnering with the Provincial Government and Kapuna Hospital. This ministry expansion on the island's south side will require us to create a floating dock where our airplanes will be fueled, maintained, and stored. We will also build staff housing on land given to us through our partnership with Gulf Christian Services.

As you read this ministry impact update, I know you will be as excited as I am to celebrate what God has done through our committed staff in 2023 and where He is leading us in 2024 and beyond! Please prayerfully consider how you can join us in reaching those in one of the most remote places on earth. Thank you for your partnership with us.

GULF PROVINCE EXPANSION

In 2023, we launched the first aviation medical outreaches this region had seen in 60 years.

The Gulf Province is one of Papua New Guinea's most underdeveloped and remote Provinces, where over 200,000 people currently live without hope and access to emergency medical care.

In 2024, we have 4 more weeks of outreaches planned, partnering with Gulf Christian Services. We are currently preparing to ship a floating dock to be assembled, and are constructing staff housing on land given to us by the Kapuna Hospital.
